4.2 Future Rides


<u>Cup Weekend Kilcunda to Wonthaggi</u> – Staying at the Kilcunda Hotel Sat night.


Sporting Club Grants Program – Potential to fund extra equipment for Aus Cycle training. Funding Round 2 opens 7th Dec and closes 15th Feb.
